Lisbon, Portugal - WYD DON BOSCO 23, the organization responsible for the participation of the Salesian Youth Movement (SYM) in World Youth Day Lisbon 2023, recently launched a series of interviews to make known the work developed by the different teams that compose it.

Intending to value and make known all the work already developed by the different teams, which are on their way to World Youth Day Lisbon 2023, the interviews were recorded at the Carris Museum, in Lisbon, and were set against the backdrop of the emblematic Electric, a means of transport so characteristic and distinctive of the city of Lisbon.

From the Coordination Team, passing the communication team, without forgetting the administration, the Events Team, The Pre-Conference Team or the Secretariat team, most of the teams that make up WYD DON BOSCO 23 had the opportunity to present themselves and present the work already developed, sharing achievements and difficulties, good moments and other more difficult ones.

Regarding the Carris Museum

Located at Santo Amaro Station, the Carris Museum tells The Story of the Lisbon Railway Company. Divided into two cores, the first presents a set of documents, miniatures, and objects that tell the history of CARRIS transport. A tram from 1901 transports visitors to the 2nd part, where the “real” transports are, which have circulated in the city of Lisbon since the end of the nineteenth century. The Carris Museum seeks to provide an exciting journey through time, telling stories of everyday life that are retained in the memory of the city and the vehicles that travel through it.
